As Scientist we will

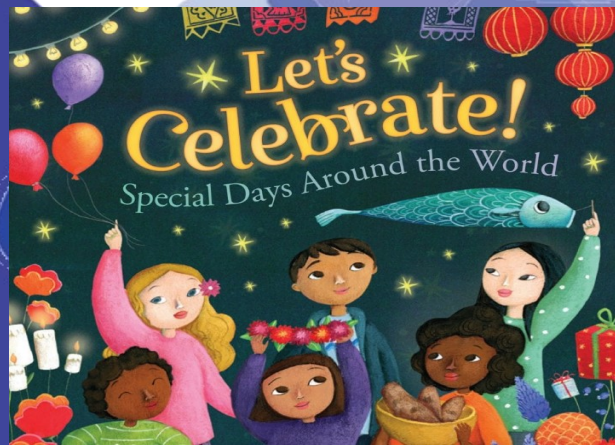
Explore and make links between the changes in the seasons.
