Learn how to subtract up to 3-digit numbers using written methods.

Explore the concept of fractions including identifying, comparing and ordering them using our understanding of the numerator and denominator. We will then progress to adding and subtracting fractions and solving problems in this context.

As Geographers we will...

Know how a coast is formed and be able to identify the human and physical features that can be found along the UK coast, with a particular focus on the local coastline. We will explore how and why coasts change over time and the impact of these changes.

In the Arts we will...

Develop our skills in working with clay and materials to create 3D maps.

As Musicians, we will listen to and appraise music inspired by coastal sounds, identify musical features and develop our understanding of the musical style. We will then use what we have learnt to create our own compositions.
