As Readers we will..

Be reading the text, *There's a Boy in the Girls' Bathroom/ Carrie's War*, we will use the text to answer comprehension questions and develop our skills of using inference to answer questions when there isn't a definitive answer.

As Historians we will..

We will also learn about the conflict in Britain due to the Reformation of the monasteries and Henry establishing the Church of England. We will make links to prior learning about conflict in Britain and further develop our understanding of beliefs and how they impact on people's actions and behaviour.
