In maths this half term the children have been learning about colours, sorting objects and creating repeating patterns. The children have also enjoyed developing their counting skills, saying numbers to ten and singing number songs.



Physical Development

The children have been developing their gross motor skills outside through climbing across obstacle courses that they have made.
