Dear Parents and Carers,

Following discussions with our Junior Leadership Team, we are pleased to advise that we have made a few changes to our KS2 arrangements at lunchtime in order to be able to bring Pokemon cards back into school from after the Easter holiday period.

The lunchtime arrangements will include all KS2 classes spending some time inside and some time outside. The inside period will be within their own classrooms where they will have access to a range of games and activities. This will also give children the opportunity to bring their Pokemon cards (or other type of cards e.g football) in so they can play with these supervised by an adult with peers from their own class. To enable this to happen, our Junior Leadership Team has also created a set of rules that all children will be following.

The children will be asked to hand all cards to their class teacher at the start of the day. These will be placed in a labelled bag in a safe place. The adult who is supporting the class during their indoor lunch period will then distribute these and collect them back in at the end of the session.

We hope you will support your child in making their lunchtimes a success by following the rules they have created through their Junior Leadership Team.
