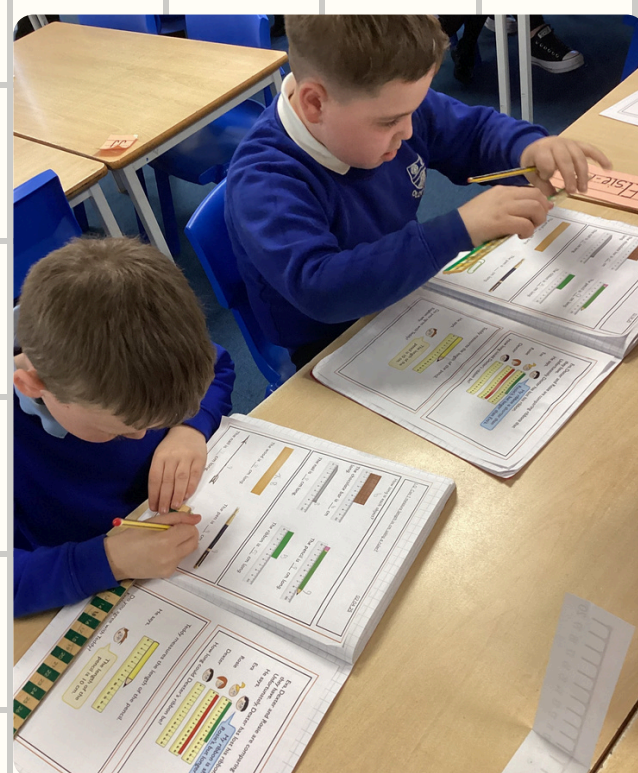




# SPRING 2 2025
