If you would like to book a place or find out more, please get in touch with the school office.



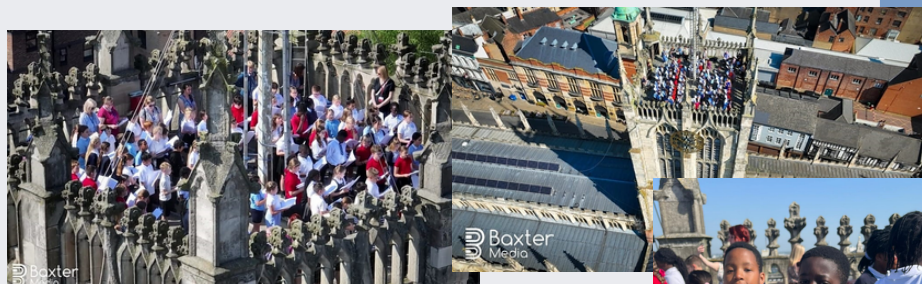
Music and Choral Hull
