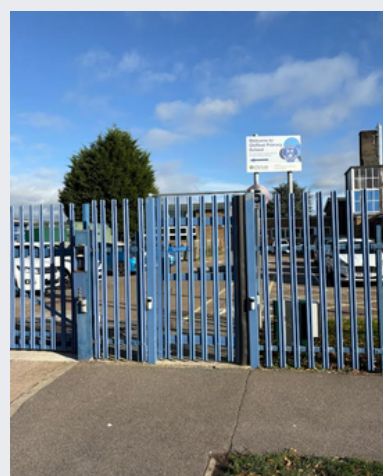


Site access
