### **Our School Procedure**

### **Sickness**

Contact the school on the day of the absence. This can be done by a phone call, a verbal message, or an Arbor message for free.

### **Punctuality**

It is vital your child arrives at school on time. If your child is late they must report to the school office and lateness will be recorded.

### **Holidays**

No holiday should be taken during school time as this will be classed as an unauthorised absence.

Unauthorised absence absences may result in a penalty of £80 per adult, per child.

### **Appointments**

Wherever possible, appointments should be made outside of school hours. If this is not possible, please provide proof to the school office. Your child must return to school after their appointment.

### **Medication**

The school can administer medication such as Calpol, antibiotics and paracetamol. Visit the school reception to give us the medication and instruction and we will be happy to give it.

#### **School Nurse**

We have a School Nurse in school on a Friday. She can support with various aspects that can affect attendance such as poor sleep and routines. Please contact the school office if you would like to see her.

### Walking bus

If you are finding getting your child in to school a challenge, contact the school office and we will support you the best we can!

We also offer a walking bus service your child can join, contact the office for more info.

# How we record attendance

Absences are recorded as authorised or unauthorised.

A child who is not in school and whose parents/carers have not contacted the school regarding their absences will receive an unauthorised absence mark. An unauthorised mark will also be recorded if the nature of the absence was unacceptable.

If the number of unauthorised absences or late marks for a child reaches 10 sessions (1 day=2 sessions) in a term, the case will be referred to the local authority. This may result in a fine.
