Maths

In Maths we have been learning about the 2D shapes, circles, triangles, rectangles and squares. We have been learning how many sides and corners they have. We have also been learning about positional language using the words, on, under, in, out, in front and behind.



Writing

This half term we have been working on developing all the children's mark making skills. The N1 children are developing the skills to draw various lines and shapes. The N2 children are developing the ability to write their own name. We have also begun teaching the letter formation for the sounds we have learnt in our phonics sessions.



Expressive Arts and Design

This half term we have been developing our design skills. We have been making shields for St George. We have been creating our own trains using junk modelling and sponge printing trains. We have also been developing our drawing skills; looking carefully at fruits and drawing them using pencil crayons and pastels.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

In our Jigsaw sessions this half term we have been talking to the children about relationships. The children have talked about who is in their family. We have talked about friendships and how we can be a good friend to one another. We have also talked about what the children can do if someone is unkind to them.

Physical Development

This half term we were very lucky to receive some new equipment for outside. The children have been developing their gross motor and balance skills, walking across the different heights. They are also good for developing their upper body strength as they like to help carry them when it is tidy time. The children also use their imaginations and like to pretend they are on an aeroplane or a train..



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
