





Maths

In Maths we have been developing our counting skills, focussing on accuracy, ensuring we say one number for one object. We have also been learning to compare groups of objects, identifying which group has more and which has fewer. In shape, we have been learning to identify the 3D shapes; cube, cuboid, sphere and cylinder.



Reading

We have enjoyed the books, Elmer, The Very Hungry Caterpillar, We All Went on Safari and Rainbow Fish. We particularly enjoyed learning how to count from one to ten in Swahili whilst we were sharing the book "We All Went on Safari.' In Phonics the chidren have been learning to read the sounds for each letter and learning to recognise their own names.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This half term we have been naming our body parts and talking about the important role each part plays for example our fingers help us to draw, catch a ball and eat. We have been talking about how we have changed since starting nursery. We have been preparing for the transition into F2 and learning about the exciting things that we have ahead of us.



Expressive Arts and Design

We have linked our creative work to the books that we have enjoyed this half term. The children have enjoyed painting their own Elmer patterned elephants and repeating pattern caterpillars. The children made their own binoculars so that they could go on a safari and they enjoyed creating their own rainbow fish with beautiful colourful scales.

Understanding the World

This half term we have been learning about the lifecycle of a butterfly. We watched our caterpillars turn into cocoons and then emerge as beautiful butterflies. We also had a visit from Tracey from Beverley Beekeepers, she taught us all about Bees and she brought real live bees for us to watch. We have planted some flowers and we have been taking care of them, watering and deadheading them.
